Games Descriptions:

WRITING GAMES: Students must work as teams to complete a specific task. Students are required to pool their knowledge and understanding of a certain book(s) and to respond imaginatively to an assignment. At the same time, they are expected to follow specific rules that are given at the beginning of the session. Entries are judged on how imaginative the projects are and how well the students followed the instructions.

WORD GAMES: Students will work together as teams to solve quick word activities that challenge the students' knowledge of the books and critical thinking skills. It would be helpful for the students to know specific information about characters, locations, names, and so forth. In the

past, this game included Vocabulary, Unscramble, Missing Vowels (MR = MARIA), and New Words (add one letter to the given word to create a new word that fits in the sentence; beak = bReak).

WRITE ON YOUR FEET: An impromptu writing contest where participants are given approximately 45 minutes to respond to the BookFest booklist-related topic that is given to them at the beginning of the session. Scores are based on creativity, attention to detail, organization, spelling, and punctuation.

HUMAN SCRABBLE: A set of alphabet cards and a timer await each team in this fast-paced game! Students must be ready to think quickly, know their spelling of nouns in the novels, and be able to move at a rapid rate for this hands-on game.

ACT OR DRAW: This game is based off of "Win, Lose, or Draw." The students will be put on a team. One person per round will draw a word and then will either act or draw to get the team to guess the word (words are based off of information from the BookFest books).

JOURNALISM: This contest will take place over the first two sessions of the morning. In the first session, the participants will learn the basics of journalistic interviewing. Next, the participants will interview our guest speaker. During the second session, the participants will use the information they learned about journalism and the notes they took during the interview with the speaker to write an article for publication for a newspaper.
